DAY 1

La Paz on Foot: Santiago de Huata Full-day

Then we get ready for a ride on the sailing catamaran built by the young people from the community, driven by the wind we let ourselves be carried away by the mystical waters of Lake Titicaca. We then head to Sunata Island, where we will take a short walk to feel the emotion of crossing the waters of Titicaca barefoot, while we delight ourselves with the typical landscapes of the Cordillera Real.
